Name Response	Name Response with small Distraction
Sit	Sit for 20 seconds with no lure
Down	Down with no lure
Nose to Tail	Demonstrates no sensitivity to touch
<b>LEVEL 2</b>	
<b>Instruction</b>	<b>Criteria to Advance to the Next Level</b>
Loose Leash Walk	Loose Leash walk at different paces
Stay	Stay for 10 seconds with handler close
"Off"	Leave a treat placed in front until released with eye contact
Stand	Go from sit to stand without forward movement 2 sec.
Recall	Recall with small distractions
<b>LEVEL 3</b>	
<b>Instruction</b>	<b>Criteria to Advance to the Next Level</b>
Stay	Stay for 30 seconds with owner at 20 ft
Loose Leash Walking	Loose Leash walk past other dogs
Recall	Recall with large distractions
Jumping	Guest approaches with no jumping
Finish	Swing to the side after a sit with lure
<b>LEVEL 4</b>	
<p><b>Level 4 gradually increases the level of difficulty for all exercises and skills previously accomplished in Levels 1, 2 &amp; 3. We work with the dog and handler to improve responsiveness in increasingly difficult situations and environments.</b></p>
